Dr. Oscar de Leon-Casasola is Chief of Pain Medicine, Director of Research and Professor of Oncology at the Department of Anesthesiology, Roswell Park Cancer Institute, Buffalo, NY. He is also the Director of the Pain Fellowship Program, Vice-Chair for Clinical Affairs, and Professor of Anesthesiology, Department of Anesthesiology, University at Buffalo, School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.

Dr. de Leon-Casasola received his medical training at the Universidad de San Carlos de Guatemala after obtaining a degree in music with specialty in Piano. He went on to complete a surgical residency SUNY at Downstate, followed by anesthesia residency at SUNY-Buffalo. He is board certified in Anesthesiology, Critical Care Medicine and Pain Management.

Dr. de Leon-Casasola is the Editor-in-Chief of *Techniques in Regional Anesthesia and Pain Management*. He also serves in the Editorial Board of Seminars in *Pain Medicine, Journal of the Spanish Society of Pain*, and *the Journal of the Argentinean Society of Anesthesiologist*. He has lectured at more that 150 academic institutions and hospitals throughout North and South America, and Europe and has authored or co-authored more than 100 papers in major scientific journals and book chapters.
