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Dr. Rebekah Hanson is a Clinical Liaison Pharmacist for Specialty Pharmacy Services at the University of Illinois Hospital and Health Sciences System (UI Health) as well as a clinical pharmacist for the pulmonary hypertension program as part of the Institute for Personalized Respiratory Medicine (IPRM) at UI Health. She is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the UIC College of Pharmacy. Her major responsibilities include establishing and implementing case management systems, specialty clinic based education, training, and safety monitoring, teaching at the college of pharmacy, and research related to her specialty.

Dr. Hanson graduated from the University of Wisconsin at Milwaukee with a Bachelor of Science in Biology and then acquired her Doctor of Pharmacy at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC), College of Pharmacy.
